**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:**

The Project consists of the design and construction of a two-story Marine Meteorology Center with outdoor courtyard, located at the Naval Postgraduate School (NPS) Annex, Monterey, California. The building will be occupied by the Naval Research Laboratory and used in administrative, research, and ancillary functions to support their mission.

The building will include six (6) broad functional areas:
